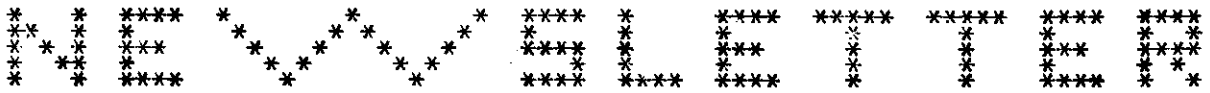


ERITH & DISTRICT SWIMMING CLUB.
