Secretary's Notes

The Club held its first Saturday Inter-Club match at Riverside Baths on Saturday, 9th October and this proved to be a very exciting contest between the five Clubs, Ravensbourne, Rochester, Gravesend, Lewisham and ourselves. Ravensbourne, Rochester and Erith battled for the first three places. The Erith team gave a good performance in all the relay events, coming first or second place in most. In the last two races, the Squadron relays, Erith were beaten into second place by Ravensbourne by one second only. Final scores were - Ravensbourne 188, Rochester 176, Erith 166, Lewisham 112 and Gravesend 68.

The team was away to Sevenoaks on Thursday 21st October when they were competing against Sevenoaks and Beckenham. In spite of the fact that a third of our team was unable to swim because of school reasons, the remainder and the reserves put up a good fight against very strong opposition to finish third. Final scores - Beckenham 114, Sevenoaks 105 and Erith 66. Owing to the difficulty of swimmers attending mid-week matches we do not propose to accept any more matches on weekdays, only on Fridays and Saturdays.
