I would like to draw your attention to the fact that the hire charge for the Pool has increased four times this year, commencing at the beginning of the year at £4.50 per hour for Classion during the week and £15 per hour for Saturday Galas. The present hire charge is now £7.40 per hour for Club sessions and commencing at the beginning of the year at £4.50 per hour for Club £22.10 per hour for Galas.
