Progress Cup <i>Based on biggest aggregate improvement in the 5 Age Group events compared with previous year (girl & boy)</i>	Chloe Reader (1 min, 16.94 seconds) (last year's winner saw a 43 second improvement) Ben Wilding (1 min, 1.19 seconds) (last year's winner saw a 48 second improvement)
Endeavour Cup <i>For consistent effort across the year, selected by the squad coaches.</i>	Tilly Burgess – <i>Tilly has worked extremely hard this year. She is consistent with her training - both attendance-wise and the actual training. One of only a handful of swimmers to swim every open in 2015 and really broadened her range of events. She also did all the Time Trials, every single Club Championship event and attended every gala that she was asked to do – even swimming in the 18/u age group (at the age of 12) in the Octopus league when we were short of swimmers. She also stepped in - without complaint - to swim individual events when swimmers were running late for the last round of WHL. To top off a great year, she qualified for her first two Kent events for 2016 which proves that the effort is paying off. Sets a good example to others.</i>
Personality of the Year <i>Putting the life and soul in to training and competition whilst still setting the right example, selected by the squad coaches.</i>	Abbi Etherington - <i>one of the friendliest faces on poolside and always got a story to tell. She makes every effort to speak to everyone in her up beat manner. She is quite vocal when there is a tough set, but digs in nonetheless and gives it everything.</i>
Swimmer of the Year <i>Statistically the most successful swimmer of the year in terms of achievement, training standard & additional contributions to the club, selected by the squad coaches (girl & boy)</i>	Danielle Hills - <i>Attained 11 Club Records in 2015. Became the first EDSC female in many years to medal at the regional championships, getting a well-earned bronze and from that final became the first EDSC female to qualify for Nationals in both Synchro and Competitive Swimming disciplines, making a final and achieving a PB.</i> James Sproston - <i>This person gives 100% in training and always asking questions on how to improve. He is ranked in the top 100 swimmers in Britain in 11 out of 17 events showing his potential for versatility, with his best placing at 9th in the 200m Butterfly. He was our only 2015 Kent Champion in the 200m Backstroke and finished off the year attaining his first Club Record in the 10/u 50m Backstroke at the final round of the NAL!</i>
