CLUB ANNUAL INTERNAL COMPETITIONS GUIDELINES

Internal competitions are defined as follows:-

1. Annual Gala Heats and Finals
2. Sprint Trophy Series
3. Points Cup Series
 - a) Dates will be published at least six months in advance.
 - b) In only very exceptional circumstances (i.e. closure of the pool) no dates will be altered after publication and then only at the instigation of the Committee who will publish a notice of any change of date and the need for such a change.
 - c) Heats will proceed in age group order or as published in the programme and any variance from this will be at the discretion of the acting referees at the time of the event.
 - d) Whilst every precaution will be taken to ensure dates do not clash with significant outside swimming events such as County School Swimming Championships and will be selected using the ASA Annual Calendar as a guide. We regret that no swimmer will be able to compete in any event they were unable to attend either before or after the published date and time under any circumstances.
 - e) All competing members are expected to participate in all annual competitions.

British Long Distance Swimming Association One hour Postal Swim

Kent Championships held February and March

Results in this year's Kent championships were the best that the club has ever achieved with most swimmers making the finals and for the first time in the history of the club we had Gold medal winners at Kent level.

Over all we won **7 gold, 6 silver and 4 bronze - well done to all swimmers.**

Congratulations to **Niki Brandsetter** who swept the board in his age group and won 4 gold, 1 silver and broke two Kent records. **Darren Chappell** won 2 gold and 3 silver which included a silver in the 400m freestyle, he also broke the Kent record in the 12yrs Butterfly and made the qualifying time for National Age Group Championships which are being held later in the year at Crystal Palace. **Hannah Spencer** had her best overall results this year winning the 127/18 yrs 100m Breaststroke and getting a silver in both the 100m Backstroke and 200m Breaststroke, she just missed out on the entry time for the National Championships in the 200m Breaststroke but she is still hoping to qualify when she swims the Southern Counties.

The 4 bronzes were won by an **Ian Magness** in the 17/18yrs Backstroke, this was also his best result from previous years'. **Lee Scott** swimming in his first Kents won a bronze in the 12yrs Freestyle he also had the fastest time in the Breaststroke but unfortunately was disqualified. **Andrew Bates** who has not been 100% fit only swam three races this year, but still won 2 bronze one of which was for the 200m Butterfly. Best of luck to **Niki Brandsetter, Darren Chappell, Andrew Bates and Hannah Spencer** who have qualified to swim in the Southern Counties Championships which are being held at Crystal Palace Starting in May.

KENT CHAMPIONSHIPS

It has been brought to my notice that for some of the parents and swimmers of our younger age groups do not understand exactly what the Kent Championships mean. The Kent Championships are swum in February and March. They are for swimmers who live in Kent or are members of a Kent club and are swam in various pools around the county.

The Kent ASA publish entry times for the championships and these you have to achieve since 1st April in the year preceding the championship entered. I normally post on the notice board the entry times and a list if you wish to enter. This would be in November / December, all entry fees are paid by the club and we submit all entries together. The championships are run like an open meet with an entry card system which you have to post in a box at the pool on the day of the event. All swimmers have to swim the heats with the fastest six going through to the finals. These sessions can be very long and possibly there might only be 2 or 3 swimmers from Erith at your session and you do not always have a lot of support. This is why we will only encourage those swimmers who achieve a good entry time to swim. I also give a chance for the younger swimmers to be timed if they feel they could achieve the times, many do not have 31 times.

For those swimmers who do well in the Kents there is then the chance to swim in the Southern counties Championships which is of a very high standard. Again this is done as the Kents with an entry time etc., these are always swum at Crystal Palace and this year we have 4 swimmers who have achieved entry times to these championships.

We have also this year for the first time got **Darren Chappell** and **Hannah Spencer** with a National entry time which covers the whole of the country. We are hoping that **Niki Brandsetter** and **Andrew Bates** will also get an entry time - these have only been achieved by a lot of hard work and dedication.

If any one wants to know about these championships please do not hesitate to ask either myself or Carol Bates (Tel 01322 408639) - just ask at the table and they will point you to us.

During the year there are various open meets that any one can enter and these give good experience to younger swimmers who perhaps do not get many club galas but enjoy racing. If you are interested please see Carol Bates or David Chappell.
