### Kent County Championships February to March 2004

We completed our most successful year ever in the Kent County Championships. The total medal haul included **5 golds, 5 silvers and 7 bronzes**. Top performer was **James Stear**, who won gold in the 200m, 100m and 50m breaststroke, and also set a new club record for the 100m. **Michael Cook** won 2 gold medals. He took more than 15 seconds off of his personal best time, and also beat the previous event best performance by more than 5 seconds. **Michael** also won the 50m backstroke event. Silvers were won by **Joe Thorogood** (200m breaststroke), **Michael Cook** (50m breaststroke and butterfly), **Tim Colman** (50m backstroke), and **Laura Porritt** in the 100m butterfly, who also took 3 seconds off of her personal best time and obtained two club records in the process. Bronze medalists included **Emma Copen** (100m medley and 50m butterfly), **Laura Porritt** (200m butterfly), **Michael Cook** (50m freestyle, 200m butterfly and 200m freestyle), and **Joe Thorogood** (100m breaststroke). Our other finalists were **Alice McCalla, James Willey, Michael Redpath, Shane Hume and Tiffany Brown**.

In the Kent Relay Championships, almost every age group made the final, with 5 teams making both the freestyle and medley finals. These included: the boys 9-12 years (**Jake Reeves, Richard Jones, Michael Cook, Tim Colman**); boys 13/14 years (**James Stear, James Willey, Joe Thorogood, Matt Kirkup**); boys 15/16 years (**Michael Redpath, Peter Sullivan, Gary Lansdale, Joe Hodges**); ladies open (**Tiffany Brown, Louise Hoyne-Butler, Laura Porritt, Shelley Carver, Sophie Evans, Helen Clifton**); and the mens open (**Phil Brown, Shane Hume, Mark Russell, David Kane**). ## OBITUARY

It is with regret that I have to announce the death of one of our Life Members. Evelyn Anderson has recently died at the age of 97. She first joined the swimming club circa 1920 and remained an active member until when she moved to Suffolk in 1960. She was a founder member of the Erith Otters Ladies Floating Display Team (and we thought Synchro was new to EDSC!) who gave displays at local aquatic events such as the Erith Regatta. Also a keen member of the Ladies Water Polo Team.

She was the main instigator of reforming the club together with my father, John McArdell after the second world war and it was her donation of £5 which gave the club sufficient funds to re-start. She taught hundreds of youngsters to swim over the years (myself included) and was instrumental in including Survival Awards in the club's activities. She was also heavily involved in Lifesaving. Her favourite stroke was breaststroke and when she retired to Suffolk she donated a cup (The Suffolk Cup) to the club especially for Breaststroke Style. This event is still held each year and Mrs A (as she was known) stated that the competition would be open to swimmers 14 years and over.

She was still swimming one mile per day at the age of 86 and was heavily involved in club life both in Oulton Broad and Stourport on Severn. She swam Masters Events in her 70s and 80s.
