Other Results

Kent County Championships February to March 2005

For the third consecutive year we came away with more medals than ever at the County Championships. This year the team achieved a total of 10 golds, 4 silvers and 10 bronzes, compared with last year's previous best total of 5 golds, 5 silvers and 7 bronzes.

This year's top individual performer was **Nick McMonagle** winning gold in the 200m Individual Medley and the 100m Freestyle, silver in the 200m Backstroke, and bronze in the 200m Freestyle, 50m and 100m Backstroke. Close behind him was **James Stear** also with two gold medals, this time for the 100m and 200m breaststroke events, silver in the 50m and a bronze in the 50m Freestyle. **Simon Facer** won two gold medals in the 200m Butterfly in the 16 years and the 16 and under age groups. **Tim Colman** won gold in the 50m Butterfly, silver in the 50m Backstroke and bronze in the 100m. For the girls, **Emma Coppen** did well in her butterfly events, winning gold in the 50m, 100m and narrowly missing out on 200m title. She also won bronze in the 200m Individual Medley. There was also success for **Laura Porritt** who won gold in the 200m Butterfly. Well done also to **Judith Goodey** (bronze in 100m Backstroke), **Jamie Perrin** (bronze in the 200m Butterfly), **Shane Hume** (bronze in the 400m Freestyle), and **James Willey** (silver in the 200m Butterfly). Our other finalists included **Bethan Austin**, **Casey Porritt**, **Elizabeth Kennedy** and **Emily White**.

In the Kent Relay Championships, almost every age group made the final, with four teams making both the Freestyle and Medley finals. Well done to the Boys 15/16 age group who managed to win bronze in both of their events, whilst the Boys Junior Freestyle team also achieved bronze.

Halloween Weekend – 28th to 31st October 2005 at Pontins, Pakefield, East Suffolk Coast

From a social day out in Brighton to a fantastically cheap family weekend with the swimming club (with no swimming or bike riding to contend with!). Once again, later this year, I'll be looking to organise another Halloween weekend away at Pontins. As usual, it's the same location - Pakefield, just south of Lowestoft on the East Suffolk coast (about 2.5 hours drive). Last year we had plenty of newcomers from the Club and it would be great if we could get even more on board this year. Being a group booking, the more people that go, the cheaper it becomes for everyone.

So what's the deal? The price includes 3 nights half board accommodation, which includes breakfast and a 3-course dinner. The food is all buffet style so you can go up as many times as you like, and there's always plenty of choice. The accommodation is spacious and relatively modern, and includes a bedroom, bathroom, TV and heater. On site facilities include pitch and putt, tennis, outdoor adventure playground, plus there's an indoor sports centre for darts, snooker, pool, table tennis, etc, and of course there's an indoor swimming pool. Most, if not all, are free. For evening entertainment there's the Queen Vic pub, the Princes showbar, and the main hall and bar which is open until 2am every night. The live act appearing this year is yet to be confirmed, but is normally a top tribute band (which has in the past included Abba, Queen and the Rolling Stones). There are also competitions for fancy dress.

So what is the price? Well, as anyone that went last year will tell you, it was meant to be £65 per person in 2004. In actual fact, once the numbers were confirmed, it was £45 per adult, and £25 per child under 18. Although prices for this year are yet to be confirmed, I don't expect it will be any more than £50 for adults and £30 for those under 18 if we manage to secure a similar discount. If you're still a little unsure about coming along just speak to the plenty that have been before. It should be noted that this isn't just limited to Club Members – feel free to invite other family members and friends along.
