latest news from the Chairman



What a busy few months it has been with lots happening at all levels in the Club. Sadly there seemed to be a notable number of absences, especially from the younger swimmers who swim in the Mini Squads. Please remember that we must have up to date times for you if you want to go on and be selected to swim for the Club at galas. If you don't take part in our internal races then your chances of being selected are greatly reduced.

Well done to Mark Nicholls, Robert Kennedy, Alex Wilkes and Joanne Ball who were appointed as Club Captains and Vice Captains for the year. This is one of the greatest honours the Club can bestow on a swimmer and reflects not only the hard work they do in the pool but also their commitment to the Club as a whole. Many congratulations!

Our Forthcoming Events page has recently been updated with new events. We have recently taken on 4 friendly galas at Dartford, Maidstone and Crawley to try and offer more swimmers the chance to compete. We can only field teams at these galas with your support, please ensure that you give it.

Of course, the big change in February was to our training programme. Initial feedback is mostly positive and it's really good to see the pool being used to its potential all night on Tuesdays and Thursdays. The Management Committee will be reviewing the alterations at their meeting at the end of March. If you have any further feedback then please let any member of the Committee know in advance of that meeting.

There is currently a vacancy for someone to take on the role of EDSC Welfare Officer. The person appointed would need to be approachable, a good listener & a good communicator. They would then be the person responsible for the implementation of good practice & child protection policies within the Club. If you can help with this, please speak to me at any time. Please remember that EDSC is run almost entirely by volunteers. We are always in need of more help. You don't have to be a swimmer to get involved you just need to be willing. At the moment we are in urgent need of people to help with the teaching of swimming and the running of galas. We will give you all the training you need and I promise you, it's much better to be doing something on poolside than to sit or stand in a packed and hot spectator gallery. If you would like to join the poolside team then please speak to me. Any offer of help is always welcome!

You may have noticed that the number of swimmers in our Learn to Swim Scheme has been a little light recently. We did advertise as usual in the Newshopper but had little response from new members. We will shortly be producing a Club Leaflet which will be dropped door to door in the local area. In the meantime it would be great if our own members tried to recruit some new children into the Club. Please spread the word in school playgrounds etc as we are very keen to see our Learn to Swim programme full again. Please remember, the young swimmers that we recruit into the Club are our future, so your assistance with this is vitally important to the future of the Club.

Finally, after much hard work by Tony Ball and others, the Club will be attempting to gain its SWIM21 accreditation in early April. SWIM21 is an initiative brought in by the ASA. It is primarily a planning tool enabling clubs to help swimmers, coaches and administrators to achieve their full potential. Good luck to all those involved with the assessment. As usual, I would like to finish by saying that if you have any questions at all then please speak to me at any training session. I can usually be found at the pool on Tuesday and Thursday evenings and Sunday afternoons.

OBITUARY—FRANK RIDER 1945-2008

It was with great sadness that we learned of the death of our dear friend and colleague on New Year's Day after an 18 month battle with cancer. It was very endearing to learn that swimming played a very large part of Frank's life, from a boy swimmer to a stately Master.

For many years Frank took a very active role in the swimming club and participated in nearly all of its events on and off poolside. He was an active committee member for a long time, always acting for the benefit of the club. In 2003 he became the Club's President, a role which he took on and enjoyed very much, always having the interest of the club at heart. At the pool during sessions Frank always greeted everyone with a big smile and a friendly welcome, taking the time to chat and talk to parents, at the same time continuing his tireless help by assisting Moya as the membership secretary.

Off poolside you would always see him with Moya and his family, including their dogs, on the club family rambles across the countryside. The whole family would attend quizzes and many other social functions, organising discos and events, and when he wasn't quite feeling up to it he would always make an appearance. On poolside Frank was a lane coach regularly teaching young swimmers and, together with Simone, was the Tudor White team manager for a number of successful years, until 2003 when they stepped down. Not only did he select the team and make sure all the swimmers were present, he even swam himself in the open backstroke events with his unique backstroke style.

Frank then went on to manage the Masters Section, which, with his encouragement, has now grown into a very large section of the club. He was active in encouraging past swimmers, many of which are now parents of young club swimmers themselves. Frank would always participate in the annual galas, swimming in master events & also the Family Relay. He would always help out as a poolside official when called upon to lend a hand, and if this were golf, which Frank did play, it would be the 19th hole in which he also participated with great enthusiasm. **KAREN HUBBARD**
