latest news from the Chairman



Hello everyone and welcome to another Club Newsletter. Please take some time to look through it and read about what has been going over recent months. Remember that we only issue newsletters twice a year and that the best way to keep up to date with events is to use both the website and our e-mail service. It would really save a lot of time if we had up to date e-mail addresses for everyone so please make the effort to let us have yours if you haven't done so already and register by sending an e-mail to news@edsc.org.uk

I would like to remind all swimmers that whatever squad they train with, minimum levels of attendance are expected. For those in our Mini, Red and White squads a minimum of 2 sessions per week is the rule and for those who train in Junior and Top squads, 3 is the minimum. At a time when the Club is full and we have a waiting list of children that are keen to join, we cannot carry individuals who are not prepared to commit to the minimum level of training.

All members are also expected to compete on a regular basis (after all that is what we train for). There were a number of members who took no part in our Club Championships during the latter part of 2008 and early 2009. Continual absence from competition may result in you being asked to leave the Club, so please make every effort to compete when required.

A reminder from our Subscriptions Secretary to please pay your instalments when they are due. We have to continually chase people to pay and this really is something that we don't have the time to do. We try our hardest to keep annual subscriptions as low as possible and having to send reminder letters again and again just adds to the cost of your membership. The Management Committee has recently considered charging members for chase up letters so please don't put us in the position of having to ask you for extra money.

Teachers and coaches have asked me to mention a couple of things. Firstly, time keeping. A number of swimmers continually turn up late for their sessions. This is not good for swimmers as the start of any session is always used to warm up. If swimmers miss the opportunity to warm up properly they can injure themselves and that is the last thing that we want to happen. Swimmers should really be on poolside, ready to swim at least 5 minutes before their session is due to start. Please don't be surprised if regular latecomers are refused entry into a session. Secondly, goggles! Teachers and coaches don't have time to alter children's goggles. Children should own 2 pairs of goggles, a comfortable pair for training and then a pair for racing. Training goggles should be comfortable and well fitted (before you come training). Racing goggles should be tight (so they don't fall off when you start). Please ensure your training goggles fit well before you come to the pool and don't expect your teacher to sort them out for you.

Sorry if I've had to moan about a few things but they are important issues that need saying.

On a positive note, well done to all who have trained hard and competed well over recent months. Good results are being achieved by all our teams and a special mention must go to those that achieved County Qualifying times and have taken part in the County Championships. Well done to those teachers and coaches who recently undertook additional training on a number of issues. This additional training will help the Club in finally gaining our SWIM21 accreditation later in March (all fingers crossed). I'm pleased to confirm that the Club is still on the Jack Petchey Scheme and swimmers are being rewarded each month with money from the scheme that goes towards extra things for the Club.

Finally, can I ask you to please support the Club in our 2 big fundraising events of the year. Everyone is invited to the Summer BBQ on the 11th July at which the usual fun, games and more will take place and everyone will shortly receive the Annual Draw tickets to sell. Remember that these fund raising events help to keep our fees as low as they are so please support them.
